Agenda item 18: Elections

The Regional Conference, which is held only once in four years, is the most representative ITF body in the region. One of the functions of the Regional Conference is to endorse the elections of the Asia/Pacific Regional Committee (APRC) and various Regional Section Committees which are held during the Regional Conference.

The positions which will be elected during the course of the Regional Conference and their election procedures are as follows:

Asia/Pacific Regional Committee (APRC)

- Members of the APRC are first confirmed by the Regional Conference.
- A meeting of the Asia/Pacific Regional Committee is held during the Regional Conference to elect its Chair and three Vice Chairs (representing each of the four sub-regions) from among the members.
- Regional Conference endorses the APRC elections

Regional Section Committees

- Regional Section Chair, three Vice Chairs, one woman and one young transport worker representatives are elected at each of the Regional Section Committee meetings.
- As the Asia/Pacific Regional Dockers Conference was held in January 2013, just prior to the Regional Conference, the elections have already been conducted.
- The election of the various Regional Section Chairs, Vice Chairs, Women and Young transport worker representatives will be presented to the Regional Conference for endorsement.
